Dear Parents

Another week has flown by. Again, it has been a week of change and new guidance to get to grips with. I know that new local restrictions faced by you all will be causing increased anxiety and logistical problems to solve. It may be useful for you to know that we still have places available in our Breakfast Club. You are now able to book a place online up to December 20.

Thank you for adhering to our rules at pick up and drop off times. It continues to be important that adults socially distance from each other and that only one adult drops their children off at school. Whenever possible, we encourage children to walk to school themselves from Year 4. If your child is in Year 4 and wants to walk to and from school themselves, we ask that you complete a form to let us know. Please contact Mrs Davison for a form. If your child is in Year 5 or Year 6, you do not need to complete a form.

Parent Consultation Meetings

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we have reorganised parent consultation meetings so that we can meet with you whilst ensuring we do not have large numbers of parents on site.

Each Phase will offer a day of appointments, running through to 6.00pm. We will ask you to sign a declaration form to say you have no Covid-19 symptoms and that you have not come into direct contact with someone who has tested positive. We will make alternative arrangements for families who are isolating. Mrs Davison will text you to let you know when appointments are available to book.
